Cybersecurity Project Experiences:

October 16 - November 3

CAD Project Experiences:

March 11 - March 28
April 29 - May 17

What is expected of me?

To be eligible to participate in a paid 20 hour project you will need complete the associated prerequisite materials first. These materials take approximately 6-10 hours of independent online learning, culminating in an end of course assessment.

You will then work virtually for 20 hours over 3 weeks on an industry project. You will work with a team of students, some of whom may be from other schools. You and your teammates will ultimately present your project to an industry expert. Your 20 hours will be spent conducting research on your project, working with your team on your final deliverable, and meeting with your industry expert. As this is a paid project, you will be required to commit to and complete the full 20 hours.

How will I be paid?

The Work-Based Learning Alliance will pay you \$300 upon completion of your 20 hour project. R
