<u>Program Requirements</u>

- 11th graders are required to complete the Basic course during the spring or summer semester
- Students will begin the second course in either Sep or Feb, that is a 9-month course that meets twice a week for a total of 300 hours, in addition they will also start their Apprenticeship requirement that spring or next summer
- All course expenses will be fully covered by NHS
- Students' NHS schedule will be revised accordingly to accommodate these classes
