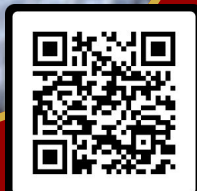


Electrical Program Requirements

- 11th graders are required to complete the **Basic Electricity** course during the spring or summer semester
- Students will begin **Journeyman Electrical I** either in Sep or Feb, this is a 9-month program that meets twice a week for a total of 300 hours, in addition they will also start their **Apprenticeship** requirement
- All course expenses will be fully covered.
- Students' NHS schedule will be revised accordingly to accommodate these classes

Electrical Program Details

This program offers hands-on training designed to prepare students for a career in the electrical field, enabling them to start working as apprentices upon completion. Students will have the opportunity to enter the workforce as entry-level electrical apprentice employees with electrical contractors, all while progressing toward licensure. Additionally, each student will receive their own set of tools to ensure they are well-equipped and ready to begin their work in the industry.
